A warm welcome to the Annual Report of Maratha Mandir Global School for 2023-24. This report reflects our journey of growth, innovation, and achievement over the past year.




WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY




TEACHERS DAY

MARATHI LANGUAGE DAY










DOCTORS DAY
