Grades I to X:

Monday to Friday – 8:55 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Saturday – 8:55 a.m. to 12:35 p.m.

Kindly ensure that your ward arrives punctually every day.

❖ **Uniform:**

Boys (Primary):

- Red checks pant and half-sleeved red shirt
- Red socks and double Velcro leather black shoes
- School black belt with Global School logo

Girls (Primary):

- Red checks skirt and half-sleeved red shirt
- Red socks and double Velcro leather black shoes
- Red cloth hairband
- School black belt with Global School logo

Boys (Secondary):

- Cream colour shirt and navy-blue pant
- Leather black shoes with lace and white socks
- School black belt with Global School logo

Girls (Secondary):

- Cream colour shirt and navy-blue checks suspender
- Leather black shoes and white socks
- School black belt with Global School logo
- White cloth hairband / white ribbon / white rubber

❖ Important Uniform Instructions:

- Parents should purchase uniforms, belts and shoes from the authorised store to avoid variations in colour, pattern and texture.
- Students should wear the prescribed school uniform only. Modification in uniform is strictly not allowed.
- Uniform must be neat, clean and properly ironed. Shoes should be polished regularly.
- Students should wear only black strap rainy footwear during monsoon.
- PT uniform must be worn only on Wednesdays with white shoes and white socks.
- Boys should maintain proper haircut. Fancy hairstyles are strictly prohibited.
- Girls with long hair below shoulder level should braid two plaits. Hair above shoulder level should be neatly tied with a cloth hairband.

❖ Leave Rules & Attendance:

- Parents are requested not to plan vacations, outings or functions during the academic year.
- Prior written permission from the Principal is compulsory for any leave.
- Students absent for more than two days due to illness must submit a medical certificate.
- Students returning after absence must bring a leave note signed by parents.
- Students will not be allowed to leave the school premises before the official closing time except in emergencies with written permission from the Principal.
- Parents will not be permitted to meet students during school hours.
- Leave during examinations for family functions, outings, or travel will not be granted.
- Examination will not be re-conducted for absent students under any circumstances.
- All students must remain present on the reopening day after vacations.
- Students absent continuously for more than two months without prior information may have their names struck off from the roll.
- A minimum attendance of 75% is mandatory to appear for the annual examination.

❖ **Tiffin Instructions:**

- Students should bring tiffin for both short and long breaks.
- No tiffin will be accepted later during school hours.
- Non-vegetarian food is strictly prohibited.
- Students should bring healthy homemade snacks for short breaks.
- Junk food is not allowed.

❖ **Stationery & Books:**

- Students must bring books and stationery according to the timetable.
- All books and notebooks should be properly covered and labelled.
- Timetable will be shared separately.

❖ **Communication with Teachers:**

- Parents are requested not to contact teachers during school hours.
- In case of emergency, kindly contact the school office.
- Parents may contact teachers after school hours between 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Kindly avoid calling teachers late at night.

❖ **Jewellery:** Students are advised not to wear valuable gold ornaments to school.
